**THE ARMY VISITS SOUTHALL PARK TO TAKE PART IN THE QUEENS
DIAMOND JUBILEE FESTIVAL**

Local Territorial Army soldiers will be taking part in the Queens Diamond Jubilee Event at Southall Park. The Soldiers based at Southall TA Centre will be in the park engaging with the public and providing information about the Reserve Forces. Also on display will be the Army's latest logistic vehicle, which is currently being used on operations in Afghanistan. The Southall based 562 Transport Squadron is part of 151 London Transport Regiment, The Royal Logistic Corps that is London's only Transport Regiment.

The Squadrons role is the transportation of ammunition, weapons, and supplies. The Squadron is equipped with the very latest vehicles and can transport up to 11 jumbo jets worth of freight simultaneously whenever and wherever the Army wants it.

Captain Derek Gregory Operational Support Officer for the Regiment said, “The Regiment is recruited from a diverse range of social, ethnic, and religious groups, from across London, which represents today's modern society. The Southall based 562 Transport Squadron is a modern TA unit operating in today's modern Army”. This event is a great opportunity for the soldiers to engage and celebrate the Queens Diamond Jubilee with the local community”.

TA soldiers are well trained, extremely professional, and operationally tested, serving in Iraq, Afghanistan and on UN peacekeeping duties in Cyprus”. The Squadron offers its soldier's part time employment, excitement, adventure, usable trade skills and a great social life.
